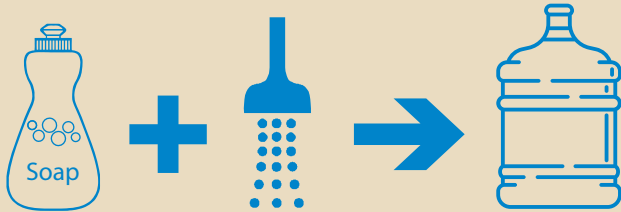


Cleaning & Preparing WATER STORAGE CONTAINERS

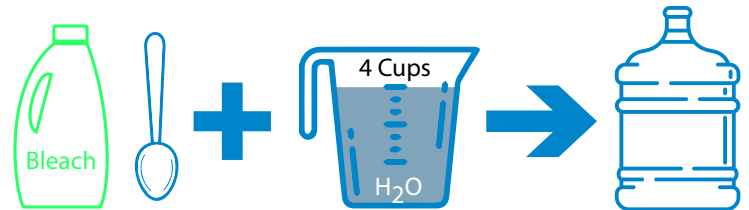
Use a clean food-grade water storage container — such as those found at a camping supply store — or a container that is made out of durable materials and can be closed tightly. **DO NOT USE** containers that once held toxic chemicals.



- 1 Wash** the storage container and **Rinse** completely with water.



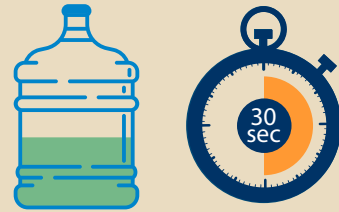
- 2 Sanitize** the container with a solution made by mixing 1 teaspoon of unscented liquid bleach in 4 cups of water.



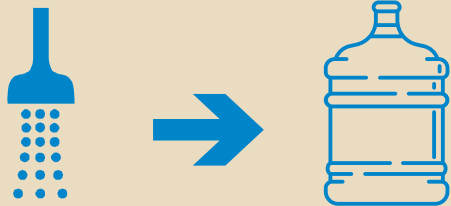
- 3 Cover** the container tightly and **Shake** it well. Make sure the sanitizing bleach solution touches all inside surfaces of the container.



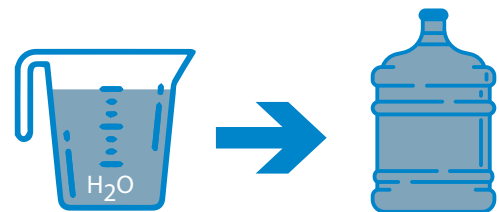
- 4 Wait** at least 30 seconds and then pour the sanitizing solution out of the container.



- 5 Air-dry** the empty container **OR Rinse** the empty container with clean, safe water already available before use.



- 6 Pour** clean water into the sanitized container and cover with a tight lid.



DO NOT STORE WATER CONTAINERS
IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT



DO NOT STORE WATER CONTAINERS IN AREAS
WHERE TOXIC SUBSTANCES, SUCH AS GASOLINE OR
PESTICIDES ARE PRESENT



KEEP STORED WATER IN A PLACE WITH A
FAIRLY CONSTANT COOL TEMPERATURE
