

MWDOC.com Cleaning & Preparing WATER STORAGE CONTAINERS

Use a clean food-grade water storage container — such as those found at a camping supply store — or a container that is made out of durable materials and can be closed tightly. DO NOT USE containers that once held toxic chemicals.













Wash the storage container and Rinse completely with water.




Cover the container tightly and **Shake** it well. Make sure the sanitizing bleach solution touches all inside surfaces of the container.



Air-dry the empty container OR Rinse the empty container with clean, safe water already available before use.



Sanitize the container with a solution made by mixing 1 teaspoon of unscented liquid bleach in 4 cups of water.




Wait at least 30 seconds and then pour the sanitizing solution out of the container.



Pour clean water into the sanitized container and cover with a tight lid.







DO NOT STORE WATER CONTAINERS IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT

DO NOT STORE WATER CONTAINERS IN AREAS WHERE TOXIC SUBSTANCES, SUCH AS GASOLINE OR PESTICIDES ARE PRESENT



KEEP STORED WATER IN A PLACE WITH A FAIRLY CONSTANT COOL TEMPERATURE
