drought-tolerant and California native plants supports pollinators and wildlife, creates healthy soils, and reduces the urban heat island effect. The Turf Replacement Rebate Program offers \$3 per square foot of grass replaced, and additional resources are available to ensure you can install a beautiful garden that you can enjoy for many years to come!

TAKE ADVANTAGE OF REBATES.

PLANT A TREE.

Trees are an environmental powerhouse! They provide shade, filter the air, and reduce stormwater runoff. The Turf Replacement Rebate Program offers an additional \$100 rebate per tree (up to 5 trees) installed in your project. Some tree species also satisfy the program's sustainability feature requirement.



PICK UP FREE MULCH.

A thick layer of mulch suppresses weeds, retains moisture for your plants, and keeps the soil cool. Mulch also releases nutrients to the soil as it naturally decomposes. OC Waste & Recycling offers free mulch to residents! Schedule your appointment to pick up free mulch at:

UPGRADE YOUR IRRIGATION SYSTEM.

Swap your sprinklers for drip irrigation. A drip system delivers water slowly and directly into the soil, reducing water lost to runoff and evaporation. The Spray-to-Drip Rebate Program offers \$1 per square foot of sprinkler irrigated area replaced with drip irrigation.
